Grade: up to 15 extra credit points will be given to high quality videos. All videos will be viewed by Ms. Mc before any are chosen to be shown to the class.

Ethical guidelines/concerns: no humans or animals should be subject to unnecessary harm during the making of your video. Every part of the video should be appropriate for school use.
